

Talent Management: Developing and Engaging Talent

We depend on talented employees to help us achieve our business goals. But without a talent strategy focused on keeping your employees engaged, they may be sending out resumes rather than working to achieve those goals. This course outlines ways you can engage your employees so they stay and continue to deliver superior performance.

How to Remove a Course from your To-Do List (if it's non-required)

Step 1: From your list of Current Training, highlight the course that you want to remove. Once selected (highlighted), the description will appear below the list of items in your To-Do area.

Step 2: In the description box for the course, click on the "Other Actions" dropdown box and choose "Cancel Registration." This will take you to the Cancellation Confirmation screen.

Step 3: In the Cancellation Confirmation screen, you will see the course title you want remove. Click on the button "Cancel Marked". Once clicked, you have been removed from the roster of that course and it will no longer appear in your Current Registration list. Please note, if your email is connected to the Learning Cart – you will receive an automatic email confirmation stating that you are no longer registered for that class.
